OUTDOOR EXCURSIONS & LEISURE TRAVEL

Berlin • 10 June

\$89 Adults, \$49 Children, \$179 Family Children younger than 3 are free!

Discover Berlin and its turbulent history in one day. Visit Checkpoint Charlie, Brandenburg Gate, Berlin Wall, surviving medieval buildings near Alexander Platz and ultramodern glass and steel structures in Potsdamer Platz. Trip departs Katterbach at 4 a.m. and returns approximately 3 a.m. on Sunday. Includes transportation only.

Bastei Bridge and Dresden • 22 July (Hiking and sightseeing trip)

On Friday we will travel to Vicenza where we will set-up camp, and then seek out a nice Italian dinner. On Saturday we will travel to Venice to enjoy the splendor this island city has to offer. On Sunday, we will travel to Verona, visiting the ancient Roman amphitheater, and the Romeo and Juliet house. Trip departs Katterbach at 0800 and returns approximately 6 p.m. on Monday. Berchtesgaden/Salzburg • 1-4 September

We first travel to The Krimml Waterfalls (total height of 380 meters, the highest waterfall in Austria), which is located in the High Tauern National Park. Afterwards we'll move on to our guesthouse in Taxenbach. On Sunday we'll visit the city of Salzburg and in the late afternoon you'll have the option to take advantage of a pool and spa located in nearby Zell am See . On Monday we'll depart Taxenbach and visit Berchtesgaden where you'll be able to explore the Eagle's Nest, visit intriguing Salt mines or take a boat ride on the magnificent Königsee Lake. Trip departs Katterbach at 8 a.m. on Saturday and returns approximately 8 p.m. on Monday. Includes transportation, 2 overnights with breakfast and dinner.

Klettersteig (Via Ferrata) in Pottenstein

Upon request for groups of 4 or more. \$39 Adults, \$29 Children, \$69 Family

Experienced and beginner climbers will find Klettersteig to be a safe and exciting experience. Modern via ferrata is a steel cable which runs along the route and is periodically fixed to the rock. Using a via ferrata kit the climber can secure themselves to the cable, limiting any fall.

Alpine Hiking: Zugspitze • 19-20 August

Join ODR on a fun-filled canoeing, biking and camping trip at the nearby Frankische Seenland. We embark near the medieval town of Ornbau and paddle along the meandering Altmuhl River that spills into the Altmuhl Lake where we will find our campground. Take a late afternoon bike ride to the bird sanctuary and on to dinner. Later that night join the lakeside party and wait for the fireworks. On Day 2, you'll paddle across the Kleine Brombachsee to the lunch spot. After lunch, you'll finish the day paddling across the Grosse Brombachsee, the largest man-made lake in Bavaria. Trip departs Katterbach ODR at 9 a.m. and includes transportation, canoes, kayaks and related equipment, bikes, camping gear, camp site fees and guide.
