CHRISTMAS MARKETS

Augsburg • December 3

\$39 adults, \$19 children, \$65 family (for transportation)

Enjoy the unique “angel performance,” set to the magnificent background of Augsburg’s City Hall. Departs Katterbach at 2 p.m., returns approximately 10 p.m.

Strasbourg, France • December 10

\$49 adults, \$35 children, \$109 family (for transportation)

One of the oldest and largest Christmas markets in France, set in front of the Strasbourg Cathedral and its famous astronomical clock. Departs Katterbach at 10 a.m. and returns approximately 10 p.m.

SHOPPING/SIGHTSEEING TRIPS

Vienna, Austria • January 7

\$99 adults, \$59 children, \$215 family (for transportation)

Visit the capital of Austria, known as the “city of music.” Vienna is the birth place of Schubert and Straus, but many other musicians including Beethoven and Mozart came to work there. It is home to numerous museums, cathedrals and amazing architecture. Departs Katterbach at 4 a.m. and returns approximately at midnight.

Karlovy Vary Crystal Shopping and Pilzen Brewery Tour February 11

Shop for incredibly beautiful Bohemian Crystal, or just enjoy the sites of this magnificent city in the former Eastern block country, Czech Republic. In the afternoon we will travel to Pilzen and tour the Pilsner Urquell brewery, home of the world’s first Pilsner beer established in 1842. Departs Katterbach at 6 a.m. and returns approximately 10 p.m.

Brussels, Belgium • March 18

LEARN TO SKI/SNOWBOARD

All instructors are certified Professional Ski Instructors of America, and American Association of Snowboard Instructors. Skills covered may include equipment familiarization, sliding, edging and pressure control movements, rotary movements, balance, turning and stopping. More experienced? We'll help you experience the challenges of steeps, moguls and deeper snow. Lessons are available on all of our one day and overnight trips upon advanced request.

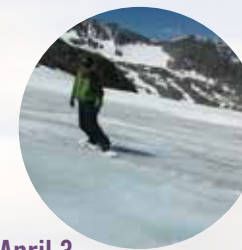
4-Day Heli-Ski/Snowboard Trip • March 10-13

LAUTERBRUNNEN, SWITZERLAND

\$589 Heli, Swiss Guide, back-country gear

Leave the lifts and the crowds behind on this exciting helicopter ski/snowboard trip in the heart of the Swiss Alps. We load the helicopters on Saturday morning in Lauterbrunnen, fly to the Ebnefluh 3,910m, follow our Swiss guide to meet our pilot and fly to the Petersgrat 3,200m, and then make our way down to the valley floor. This trip is designed primarily for advanced skiers, snowboarders may participate, however, there are stretches of flat terrain connecting the slopes that are generally difficult for snowboarders to negotiate. Prefer conventional ski lifts and groomed trails? Ski/ride the wonderful slopes of Wengen and/or the Schilthorn. Non-skiers and sight-seers may also join and find plenty to do in the surrounding area. Departs Katterbach at 8 a.m. on Saturday and returns approximately 6 p.m. Monday.

CODE OF RESPONSIBILITY

Always stay in control, and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.

People ahead of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.

You must not stop where you obstruct a trail, or are not visible from above.

Whenever starting downhill or merging into a trail, look uphill and yield to others.

Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment.

Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails.

Prior to using any lift, you must have knowledge and ability to load, ride and unload safely.
