### CHRISTMAS MARKETS

**Augsburg - December 2**

 Enjoy the unique "angel performance," set to the magnificent background of Augsburg's City Hall. Departs Katterbach at 2 p.m. and returns approximately 10 p.m. on Saturday.

**Köln - December 9**

# SKI AND SNOWBOARD PROGRAM

## LEARN TO SKI/ SNOWBOARD

All instructors are certified Professional Ski Instructors of America, and American Association of Snowboard Instructors. Skills covered may include equipment familiarization, sliding, edging and pressure control movements, rotary movements, balance, turning and stopping. More experienced? We'll help you experience the challenges of steeps, moguls and deeper snow. Lessons are available on any of our one day and overnight trips.

### SKI/SNOWBOARD LESSONS

Lift tickets and/or equipment not included.

#### \$29 Group Lessons

These lessons are designed to familiarize yourself with snow sports and teach you the basics in a safe environment, and to get yourselves underway to enjoying the mountain life.

#### \$45 Private Lesson (1.5 hrs)

Private lessons are available upon advanced request.

### WEEKLY LESSONS

**Wednesdays • January, February, March (snow permitting)**

**\$39 Transportation, ski/snowboard package and one 2.5 hrs instruction session**

Learn to safely slide down the slopes, ride the lifts and enjoy the world's fastest growing winter activities. Depending on the weather and slope conditions, instruction will be conducted locally at Burgbernheim, between Ansbach and Illsheim. Learn the basics on a gentle slope and also how to ride the lifts. All sessions will depart from Katterbach at 4:30 p.m., weather permitting.

### ALPINE TOURING

#### "Earn Your Turns"

As an alternative to standing in lift lines at some of the resorts we'll be visiting this season, take a pair of our state-of-the-art Alpine Touring Skis with climbing skins and make your own way up the mountain. Not only do you save the price of a lift pass, you'll get a fantastic cardiovascular work-out amidst some of the most beautiful scenery you can imagine. Once atop the mountain, remove your climbing skins, put them in your backpack, lock down your bindings in alpine ski mode, and ski down enjoying every turn you've just earned.

**\$129 adults, \$79 children, BOSS \$110**

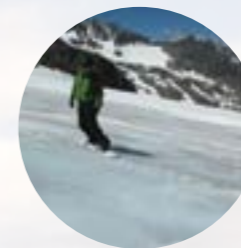

### CODE OF RESPONSIBILITY

Always stay in control, and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.

People ahead of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.

You must not stop where you obstruct a trail, or are not visible from above.

Whenever starting downhill or merging into a trail, look uphill and yield to others.

Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment.

Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails.

Prior to using any lift, you must have knowledge and ability to load, ride and unload safely.
