12 – TROPHY PREPARATION / BLEACHING



To obtain 30% Peroxide, go to an *Apotheke* with your hunting license and a print-out of this slide.

- ✓ Pour Peroxide lightly over the trophy, and catch the excess in a medium-sized pan or pot.
- ✓ Try to keep the Peroxide from splashing onto the antlers.
- \checkmark No more than ¼ of the bottle/container is more than enough to bleach a Rehbock trophy.
- ✓ Use a ½" paint brush to carefully brush excess peroxide onto all places that are to be bleached.
- ✓ Place the trophy in sunlight until it dries.
- \checkmark The bleaching does not happen immediately. Sunlight helps produce quality results.
