Victim Advocacy

The Family Advocacy Program (FAP) provides educational information, resources, and services to assist anyone that may be a victim of violence, an offender in an abusive relationship, or a person impacted by violence.

Victim Advocates

- On call 24/7
- Provides support to the abused individual
- Offers a full range of safety services to victims of domestic violence about their rights as a victim
- Assists in obtaining protection orders
- Provides referrals

New Parent Support Program (NPSP)

NPSP is a FREE voluntary program that offers home visitations to give parents and expected parents the opportunity to learn and ask questions about pregnancy, child development, discipline, parenting, nutrition, and more! All military families expecting a child or with children (0-3) are eligible to participate in all services offered.

Emergency Placement Care

Emergency Placement Care (EPC) is a temporary, short-term program that provides 24 hour care in a certified EPC home for eligible children who cannot be cared for by their natural family or legal guardian. EPC does not lead to the option for adoption. The EPC Program is in need of families who are willing to become certified providers. Interested Families can obtain an application by contacting the ACS Family Advocacy Program.

Skills for Life Education

Family Advocacy provides life skills classes that are aimed at building on individual and family strengths, increasing protective factors that have been found to reduce risk, and promote the safety and well-being of service members, their partners, and family members.
