FORT LEAVENWORTH ROD & GUN CLUB MASTER ANGLER PROGRAM RULES

PURPOSE: To recognize Rod & Gun Club members as "Master Anglers"

ELIGIBILITY: All members (including spouses and dependent children in good standing (dues paid prior to submitting application)

RULES:

- The Master Angler Program year coincides with the Rod & Gun Club membership year.
- Fish must be caught using rod & reel only (no trotlines, jugs, nets, gigs, etc).
- A <u>Club Member</u> must submit a non-returnable photo along with his/her signed application. The signature attests that the information is accurate. However, if a photograph is not available, have the application signed by a witness of the catch and state on the form that no photograph is available.
- Fish need to be weighed on a reliable scale.
- Only fish caught in Kansas, Missouri, Nebraska, Oklahoma or Colorado waters are eligible.
- The completed application must be submitted to the Rod & Gun Club Fishing Coordinator, or other elected officer.
- Applications may be submitted for the following fish that meet the minimum weight as shown:

SPECIE OF FISH

MINIMUM WEIGHT

Largemouth Bass, Brown Trout, Walleye	5 pounds
Striped Bass	15 pounds
Spotted, Smallmouth Basss, Rainbow Trout	3 pounds
Bluegill/Sunfish (Green or Red Ear)	1 pound
Catfish	15 pounds
Crappie	2 pounds

AWARDS:

- A Master Angler certificate and a unique sew-on patch will be presented for each qualifying fish. Additional patches may be purchased.
- A specie-specific sew-on rocker will be issued in each year that an eligible fish is caught (one each per specie)
- Awards will be presented at the next general membership meeting following the application's approval.
- Any conflicts with the rules as stated will be presented to the Activities Committee for a final decision.
