Camp Hours & Cost

9 a.m. - 1 p.m. Weekly & daily fees available

- Camp fees cover youth 9 a.m. 1 p.m. Camp fees follow total family income categories. Specialty camps are a set fee, different from fee categories.
- Completion of Department of Defense Fee Application (DD Form 2652) is required to establish a fee payment category. Failure to complete and submit DD Form 2652 would automatically place your household in fee category 9.
- Payment for week-long camp is due the Monday prior to the camp week. Camp enrollment is not guaranteed until payment is received. Camps and trips are filled on a first paid basis.
- Youth may sign up for the week or some individual field trips. Costs for individual field trips vary. Please contact the Youth Center for details.
- Youth are not allowed to sign themselves out of the facility during camp hours without parent permission.

Open Recreation

1 - 7 p.m. No Cost

- Open recreation hours are offered at no cost to all registered youth. Optional trips may be offered with a fee.
- Youth attending the MST Program need to arrive no earlier than 1 p.m. unless registered for summer camp.
- ♠ Open recreation activities include tech, gaming, arts and crafts, sports, snack, and more. Check out the weekly schedule for additional activities offered.
- Youth may sign themselves in and out of the facility after 1 p.m. Parents should discuss limits with their children. Please ask a staff member if you would like more information, ask about other sign in/out options or the Reserved Care Program.
- Personal Property: CYS Services is not responsible for any lost or stolen items and discourages youth bringing in valuable items such as handheld game devices: iPods. etc.
- Special Needs: If your child has asthma, allergies, diabetes, seizures, or any other special needs, additional paperwork is required, and a Multidisciplinary Inclusion Action Team (MIAT) review must be completed prior to starting with CYS.
