Vehicle Decoration/Set-up: Thursday, 15 December, 2 p.m. - 4:30 p.m. Vehicle Judging: Thursday, 15 December from 4:30 p.m.-5:30 p.m. Awards Presentation: Thursday, 15 December at 6:00 p.m.

## Parade Date: Thursday, 15 December

Parade Start Time: Thursday, 15 December 6:30 p.m. Parade Start Location: Parking Lot in front of building 5805, adjacent to Katterbach Bowling Center Parade Finish Time: Thursday, 15 December 7:30 p.m.

\*The Garrison has arranged for Santa to be on the last vehicle in the Parade. No Live Santa allowed on any entry \*

## Parade Theme: Holly Jolly Holidays

\*Each participating group or individual vehicle must complete an entry form in order to participate in the Parade. Decorations: All entries must be decorated in a tasteful holiday manner to reflect the Holly Jolly Holidays theme.

- Vehicles can be decorated at the Parade start location beginning at 2:00 p.m. on 15 December.
- Vehicles must be decorated and in place at the Parade start location not later than 4:30 p.m. to be considered for awards.
- Decorations, must be solidly attached, as they may be driven at 15 mphs.
- Each vehicle is responsible for their own trash and clean up.
- Front windshield and mirrors must remain clear. Rear windshield must allow the driver to see behind them.
- Music in car must reflect the Holiday time and be tasteful.
- Lights should not be so bright that they interfere with other drivers.

\*For safety reasons, **No** throws or candy throwing allowed. It will be dark and difficult of see if children run into the street.

\*Only Forward motion! We need continuously moving parade from start to finish. Watch for MP directions or emergency vehicles use.

\*Each driver is responsible for keeping two car lengths space between themselves and the vehicle in front of them.

\*All vehicles must stay in the parade line up as assigned at entry.

\*Consider the safety and comfort of your riders, and other participants, especially the children.

#### Vehicles requirements:

- All Vehicles are required to have working headlights, tail lights and break lights.
- All Vehicles must be driven by a licensed driver.
- Every participant must be riding in or on a vehicle.
- No walkers, bikes, skates, or other non-motorized wheeled items allowed in parade line up.
- Trailers attached to vehicles will be allowed. If people will be riding on trailer, it must be deemed safe.

- Everyone including children and animals riding in vehicles must wear a safety restraint or harness during the Parade.

\*\*Any person operating a motorized vehicle in a reckless manner is cause for immediate removal from the parade.

\*\*No alcohol will be allowed in the parade or on grounds at parade lineup.

### Before the Parade:

- Each vehicle will be assigned a number. That is your place in the lineup for the parade, and your parking space number, for onsite car decoration.

- The name that is listed on entry is responsible for the notification and information distribution to all their participants or riders.

- All current COVID-19 mitigation rules must be followed while decorating vehicles and in the vehicles.

## Judging:

Judges will evaluate the entries on:

- Best Unit Vehicle
- Best Individual Vehicle
- Best Family Vehicle
- Best Organization (Non-Military) Vehicle
- Best Use of Lights
- Most Creative
- People's Choice Award

Judging will take place on Thursday, 15 December from 4:30 p.m.-5:30 pm with the awards presentation at 6:00 p.m.
