The Tournament will be a group play and the winners will be decided through a leaderboard system, based on the total points earned over the 5 rounds.

The game mode is a Warzone Mini Royale Duos with a points system in place as follows:

· Placement Points:

1st 15 pts 2nd 13 pts 3rd 9 pts 4th 7 pts 5th 5 pts 6th 3 pts 7th 1 pt.

Kills will be awarded points with 1 kill being equal to .5 points,

- In the event of a Disconnect, players will be awarded the points they have earned up to that point in the round
